## **Food Donations**

We regularly distribute food to people as part of the food aid programme. We carry the boxes from the vehicles that supply these foods to the warehouse and organise them.

# Vila de Cucujães is a **SMALL RURAL VILLAGE**



#### Accommodation

You will share a house with other volunteers! The house is fully equipped with all appliances, and it has Wi-Fi. You might have to share the bedroom with another volunteer of the same gender, if necessary.



#### Meals/ Food

You will receive 150€/month for food allowance. There is coffee, tea and snaks available at the Red Cross for morning and afternoon breaks.





Vila de Cucujães is a small rural village located between Porto and Aveiro in the North Region of Portugal. It has an area of about 10,42 Km2 and not more than 10.705 habitants.

Vila de Cucujães is part of Oliveira de Azeméis municipality and belongs to the district of Aveiro.





Health Insurance will be provided through Cigna for the duration of the volunteering project. It is the volunteer's responsability, with the help of sending organisation, to take care of the Visa. The Volunteer's Passport expiry date should be 6 months longer than the date of the end of the project.

### TRAVEL

Volunteers will be re-funded the value of their travels (2) from Turkey to Portugal (to start the project) and back to Turkey (at the end of the project). The reimbursment will be made by the Turkish sending organisation.



## WORKING TIMES

The organisation is opened to the public from 9 am to 6pm from Monday to Friday. Volunteers are expected to work from 9:30 to 12:00 (morning period) and from 14:30 to 17:00 (afternoon period). It is important to remember that due to the nature of the organisation, we are"on call" should it be the case we are called to operate in any unexpected situation.

## POCKET MONEY

Volunteers receive 5€/ day of pocket money (as forseen on ESC guidelines). This amount will be paid monthly.


